Use as a single use item and dispose of as clinical waste after each task / procedure / episode of care.



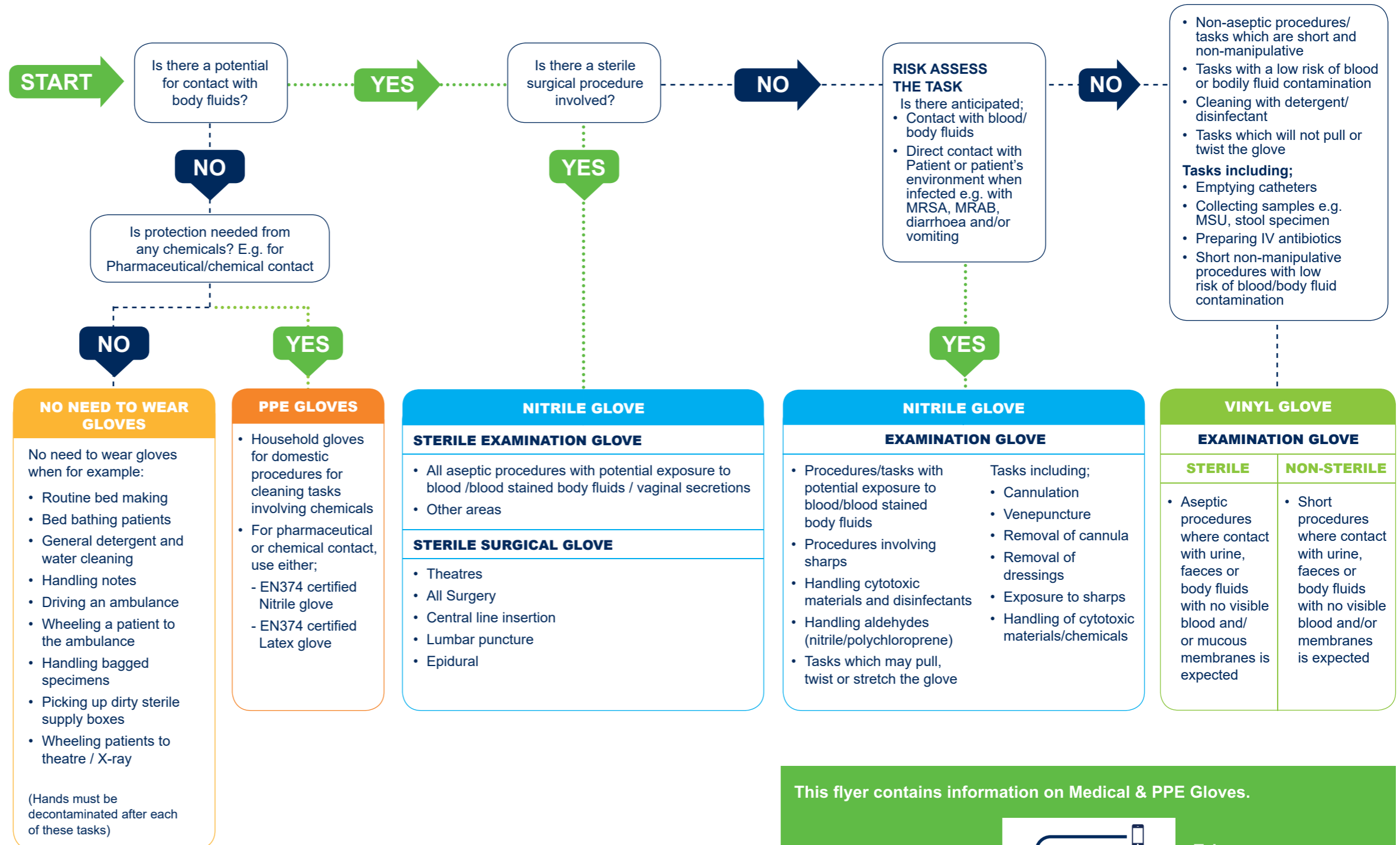
04 DECONTAMINATION & HAND HYGIENE
